School Report Rae Molzan	<ul> <li>For the 2017/2018 school year the government has passed Bill 1 which is an act aimed at reducing school fees for families. This means that families will no longer be required to provide basic school supplies for their children. Parents will still be required to pay for field trip fees and (BYOD – Bring Your Own Device) in grades 4-12. Last year parents had the option of choosing a basic or premium supplies list. Basic supplies will now be provided by the school, but there may be the choice to purchase supplies for students from the premium list.
