We will be applying for the Council Priority Funding grant and will be looking into other grants as well. We are confident that after the silent auction is done we will meet our fund raising goal. We will however continue to raise funds to improve our outdoor space. We would like to create an outdoor space for junior high students among other things. • <i>Winter Wonderland Dance</i> – The dance was held on February 22, 2019. We had around 25 families attend. The carnival games were well received by the kids. Our DJ for the evening was a St. Luke parent Nathan Knysh, he did such a great job that Brenda Watmough will be looking into having him DJ the Halloween dance. • <i>Silent Auction and Dinner at OLPH Parish Hall</i> – Will be held on Saturday March 30, 2019 @ 5:30 p.m. AGLC rules require that we provide security for this event. Tickets are on sale till Wednesday March 13. We've sold 66 tickets to date, we need to sell three more tickets to break even.
